



What the Urban Servant Corps can do for you!

1. ***Provide enthusiastic young people*** to speak to your church, youth group, Bible Study group, Sunday School, Adult Sunday School, Women's, Men's, and any other group that you may have.
2. ***Provide a safe place for congregations or congregational ministries*** to come into the city and experience the many exciting ministries going on there. The USC has two annually scheduled gatherings; Open House in the Fall, and a Spring Event, formerly the Palm Sunday "Prayer Walk."
3. ***Offer a weekend "Plunge" experience*** for youth, confirmation, family or adult groups. This is another opportunity to do service and learn about life in the city.
4. ***Provide a fresh voice to supply preach*** on Sunday mornings. Either Laura Folkwein, Executive Director or one of our volunteers can provide this service.
5. ***Provide a drop off site for Lutheran World Relief donations.*** We have a large room at 1660 Ogden St. that serves as a drop off site for LWR. Once a year a semi-truck load of quilts, medical kits, school kits, layettes, sewing kits, and soap are sent to Minnesota to be shipped worldwide. See www.lwr.org for donation info.
6. ***Be a resource for groups looking for independent service projects.*** This can be done on site through our Plunge Coordinators, by attending our annual fundraisers to learn more about agencies in the Denver Metro area, or by looking at our quarterly newsletter to get service ideas.
7. ***Provide a place to join our volunteers for monthly worship and Bible Study.*** The communities of USC join in prayer, worship, and Bible Study at least one week night per month. You are welcome to join, just call to arrange a visit!
8. ***Support you and your congregation in your prayer life.*** At your invitation we will gladly include your concerns in our prayers.

What your congregation can do for the USC:

1. ***Adopt a volunteer.*** Each of our volunteers cost about \$15,000 per year to support. The agency where they serve full-time covers \$11,000 of that. For \$500 per month your congregation could sponsor a volunteer, who would in turn be in relationship with your congregation.
2. ***Adopt a room.*** Your congregation can get together to fix up a room in one of our 100+ year old community houses.
3. ***Design a special offering to USC, or include us in your next budget.*** Laura will be glad to come and meet with your church council to let them know of all the great reasons to do this.
4. ***Bring a group to help load the LWR truck.*** Let us know of your interest and we'll contact you before our next loading date.
5. ***Provide an Urban Servant Corps Representative from your congregation.*** Someone to keep in touch with the happenings at USC.
6. ***Pray for the USC and the USC volunteers.***
